

## **Section 11 Pasture And Field Competition**

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per entry per class (entry fee inclusive of GST)

This Competition is designed to encourage the cultivation of Improved Pastures.

There will be preliminary assessment of the pastures in Autumn and a final assessment in Spring.

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

#### **(ALL PASTURES)**

The Competition is restricted to Properties in the Scenic Rim Council and/or properties in the area previously known as the Beaudesert Shire (This being the southern side of School Road, Logan Reserve; Coplick Road; Old Greenbank Road and Teviot Road).

The area shall not be less than 4 acres (1.6 ha.), and each area entered must be clearly identified and delineated, but more than one entry may be made from any property. Where legume and grass are in separate areas the minimum total area will be 8 acres. (3.2ha.) The decision of the Judges will be final, and if the merit of the entry is not in the opinion of the Judges sufficient to entitle it to an award, the Judge may withhold an award.

Entries made are subject to the Rules and By-Laws of the Beaudesert Show Society.
