JUDGE:

All honey and pollen must be shown in a round jar (not panelled) of clear glass with a white top, containing 500g reputed net weight. To expedite judging, jars should be filled to capacity with an air space of 6mm to be left at the top of the jar. Unless otherwise stated, all exhibits in this Section must be the property of the exhibitor's own apiary or apiaries. **THE EXHIBITOR'S NAME MUST NOT APPEAR ON ANY EXHIBIT.**

Where multiple entries are made by any one exhibitor in any one class, it is essential that individual exhibits be derived from a different FLORAL source.

Judging will be conducted by a Judge appointed by the Association.

Where, in the opinion of a Judge, an entry is entered in a wrong class, the Judge may refer the matter to the Chief Steward who upon the recommendation of the Judge, and at his own discretion may transfer such entry to the class for which it is eligible. Entries will be accepted on Thursday evening 2nd September 2010 until 8pm and also on Friday morning 3rd September 2010 until 9am when entries close.

Judging commences 10am, Friday of show.

PRIZEMONEY unless otherwise stated: First \$5, Second \$2.50. A third prize of \$1.00 will be given in classes with more than six entries.

**Class 13010 Pollen, cleaned and dried, 2 jars
Comb Honey**

Cut comb and the frame of honey in the Classes 1311 and 1312 must be free of paper and decorative borders so that the entire comb surface can be judged. Frames to be exhibited in a single frame observatory hive, painted gloss white.

Class 13011 Two sections of cut comb

Each section not less than 250g (nominal weight) of uniform size

Class 13012 Frame of comb honey - any size

First prize One Queen Bee Donated by Weatherbee Apiaries.

Beeswax

Class 13013 Beeswax-Yellow Minimum 1kg weight

Class 13014 Beeswax-Yellow Minimum display of Five Tablets. Total weight min of 1kg

Class 13015 Beeswax-White Minimum 1kg weight

Class 13016 Beeswax-White Minimum display of Five Tablets. Total weight min of 1kg

Class 13017 Beeswax - Candle

Class 13018 Beeswax-Display of Moulded or Sculptured Form

Total weight not less than 3kg. Display can be in coloured Beeswax and Beeswax only. Maximum number of three entries per person. First prize \$10, Second prize \$5.
