6 Exhibits are to be collected on Sunday 5th September 8.30am - 10.30am.

7 The Show Society will not be responsible for exhibits not collected.

8 MAXIMUM OF TWO ENTRIES PER PERSON PER CLASS UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

9 All work must be the work of the exhibitor and must not have won a prize at any previous show of this Society

10 Separate exhibitors must be named in group exhibits for awarding points.

11 Exhibits cannot be entered for, nor compete in more than one class. Stewards will re-class an article if considered appropriate.

12 In all classes the Judge will take into account the QUALITY of the work in making awards, which may result in NO 1st Prize being awarded.
