Regulations and By-Laws:-

1. Animals to be under 2 years of age as at the 1st June.
2. All calves must be free of ticks. Calves over six months of age must be from an accredited free or certified free herd for E.B.L. or have had a negative test within six months of Show. Provided an appointment is made with Dr John Ryan and calves are brought to his Albert Street Veterinary Clinic, calves will be tested free of charge, excluding laboratory fees.
3. The Stewards reserve the right to remove any person be it exhibitor or spectator who cause problems during the days proceedings.
4. For the open section all animals must be registered or eligible to be registered with their respective breed societies.
5. Entries are restricted to one calf per child and one child per calf.
6. The ages of handlers to be calculated as on the day of the Show.
7. All dairy cattle entering the showgrounds must be fitted with a NLIS ear tag.

CONDITIONS:-

This competition is open to all persons under the age of 25 years as at the 1st May, 2010.

1. Competitors under 18 years must have approval of parent or guardian to attend and it is the responsibility of parent or guardian to make arrangements on behalf of the competitor.
2. All Competitors to be a resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to the competition or be attending a college in Queensland.
3. Eligibility:- National Winners and persons on breed society senior judging panels are not eligible. Once a person has won the state competition twice they are to stand down for two years.
4. A Competitor can represent only one Show Society in any Sub Chamber final and only one Sub Chamber in the State Final.
5. A Show winner is not eligible to win at any other show but may participate after informing the Steward of previous win.

6. No Entry Fee is required, but entry is subject to approval of the Show Committee.
