**PROJECT INFORMATION: INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY CONSTRUCTION**

- There will be two separate classes - Middle School Class (Yr7 - Yr10) & a Senior School Class (Yr11 & Yr12)
  - Maximum of 3 entries per school
  - To be developed from the woodwork / metalwork curriculum
  - Size cannot exceed the base foot print of 50cm x 50cm, maximum height of 1m
