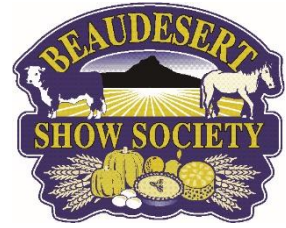

DEMOLITION DERBY SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

This event will be a Demolition Derby conducted under the National Competition Rules (NCRs) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), these supplementary regulations, and any further regulations and bulletins which may be issued. By entering this event, you agree to comply with these regulations.

EVENT SCHEDULE: Gates Open 8.00am and close at 11.00pm.
Scrutineering will commence at 10.00am.
The compulsory drivers meeting begins at 3.30pm. Anyone failing to attend must present to the Clerk of Course or risk exclusion from the event.

1. ENTRIES

- 1.1. Entries are now open and will close on Friday 26th August 2022. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 1.2. Only entries completed by the official entry method and accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 1.3. This even is only open to those competitors holding a current AASA Extreme Licence. To apply for the special event licence (1 day only) visit www.aasa.com.au/licences

2. ENTRY FEE

- 2.1. The entry fee is \$45.00
 - 2.1.1. Entry fee includes gate entry fee for one person

3. INSURANCE

- 3.1. Personal Accident insurance is provided under the AASA permit. Details can be found at www.aasa.com.au

4. DRIVER APPAREL

- 4.1. Driver's apparel shall be specified in AASA Appendix 4 Apparel Requirements for Extreme Events. Please see www.aasa.com.au for further details.
- 4.2. In addition to the AASA Appendix 4 Apparel Requirements, all competitors must wear a Neck brace during the event.

5. VEHICLE AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- 5.1. Each vehicle must comply with the **Beaudesert Show Society Demolition Derby Build Rules 2022**.

6. SCRUTINY

- 6.1. Scrutiny will begin at 10.00am. Please bring your completed pre-scrutiny form if applicable.
- 6.2. Vehicles entered in the competition must have completed scrutiny prior to participating in any track activities. Scrutiny will be as per section 9 of the AASA Event Operations Manual.
- 6.3. Current licences and full driving apparel must be presented at scrutiny.

7. PASSENGERS

- 7.1. Strictly no passengers permitted in this event.

8. COMPETITION RULERS

- 8.1. Each driver must comply to the **Beaudesert Show Society Competition Rules 2022** approved by AASA July 2022.
- 8.2. Vehicles must remain in the competition area
- 8.3. Any use of mobile phones during the event is strictly prohibited.
- 8.4. Any driver not adhering to these rules will be eliminated from the competition immediately.

9. PROTESTS

- 9.1. Protest – please refer to the Beaudesert Show Society By-Laws section 8.

10. AWARDS & PRESENTATIONS

- 10.1. Judging will be done on the night and winners will be presented their prizes directly after.
- 10.2. Appointed BSS officers/stewards' judgement will be final.

11. FACILITIES

- 11.1. The Beaudesert Show Grounds is private property. Competitors and pit crew must respect that of the rules and requirements set by the Beaudesert Show Society.

12. SMOKING

- 12.1. The Beaudesert Show Grounds has a strict no smoking policy. Designated smoking areas are located around the grounds. There is strictly no smoking in the pit area, anyone caught smoking will be asked to leave the event.

13. DRUGS & ALCOHOL

- 13.1. Consumption of alcoholic liquor by drivers or pit crew is forbidden prior to the completion of the event in accordance with the Schedule 3 of the NCRs. All drivers must have BAC of 0.00 and no illicit drugs in their system.
- 13.2. All competitors and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition.
- 13.3. Any driver pit crewmember being found to be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs during the event will be excluded from the event with no refund.

14. FUEL

- 14.1. Fuel can only be stored in 20 litre fuel drums or containers that meet AS1940/AS/NZS2906 or higher in order to comply with OS&S requirements and the Dangerous Goods Act 1985. There is a maximum of 1 x 20 liter containers per vehicle.
- 14.2. Refuelling may take place outside of the pit area, on the main ring after the competition of the parade and presentations. All drivers and pit crew must be outside of the vehicles while refuelling. An authorised BSS team member must be on stand-by holding a fire extinguisher during the refuelling process. To refuel you must be given permission to access the area. For safety purposes a maximum of 4 vehicles at once can be refuelling. The order of refuelling will be at the discretion of the safety officer in charge.

15. FIRES

- 15.1. Most fires are in the carburettor and will burn themselves out in a short time. In the case of a fire: **DO NOT** pump the pedal or keep winding the motor over. The officials will see you and will evaluate the situation and respond as necessary. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR CAR.**
