## RULES

**Grounds opening time: Entry to the Beaudesert Show Grounds is via Jane Street (gate#6) and Tina Street (gate #5) - which will be open from 9.00 am Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> March. Entry onto the grounds is strictly prohibited before this time.**

1. No telephone nominations or late nominations accepted. The draw will be available on the Show's website & ACA website.
2. All nominations must be via Campdraft One.  
[www.campdraft.com.au](http://www.campdraft.com.au)
3. **Limited to 8 first round runs excluding the restricted and futurity drafts.**
4. **Cattle levy kept of \$20.00 per scratching per run scratched.**
5. **SCRATCHINGS: if a competitor scratches from this event then ACA D.5 rules apply.**
6. All scratching's and/or changes to horse rider combinations must be made 20 minutes before the nominated draft begins.
7. ***NO CHANGES to DRAW will be accepted after commencement of program. Changes to horse/rider combinations to be made prior to 20 minutes before the draft starts.***
8. Entry money to be receipted before nominations are allocated and prize money and /or refunds will be bank transferred after the draft.
9. Dress: Campdraft competitors must wear a hat, not cap, or safety helmet, boots, collared full buttoned shirt and long trousers in competition at all times. Competitors must be neat and presentable.
10. Competitors must be suitably attired and mounted for presentation.
11. Every horse to be named. All horses to be run in order of draw.
12. All competitors in all events compete at their own risk.
13. The decision of the Campdraft Committee on all matters will be final.
14. In the event of a tie for first place, competitors concerned will compete in a further round to decide the winner.
15. All conditions to apply at time of draft and nominations in any event will be taken as acceptance of the above conditions.
16. **HORSE'S STATUS:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Mini, Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
17. **Only committee members and stewards are allowed to work in the ring.**
18. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the committee dismisses the complaint, the \$20 is forfeited.
19. No Alcohol to be brought onto Showground.
20. **Beaudesert Showgrounds is a Glass Free Zone.**
21. **The committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any event or entry and to refuse any nomination.**
22. Stallion Service Prizes – To be taken in 2023 breeding year. Does not include any vet costs or agistment fees. Has to be taken at a time both parties agree to. **Services are NOT TRANSFERABLE, winners names are provided to sponsor.**
23. Minimum Stallion Containment Requirements - ACA Rule 11.12  
In daylight hours you may either:  
A: Stallions to be double tied. Stallions to have an exclusion perimeter erected around the horse and area they are tied to excluded any possible interaction between the stallion and another horse or human.  
OR  
B: Stallions to be enclosed by panels. Stallions can be free to roam inside the panel area when an exclusion perimeter is erected around the panelled area to exclude any possible interactions between the stallion and another horse or human. Only 1 horse allowed per enclosure. Panels must be a minimum of 1500mm in height. Panels must be constructed using an equivalent of 4 solid object i.e truck, post or tree. The same rules apply to daylight hours with the addition for a stallion that is in panels must have at least one additional form of restrain eg: tiedup, hobbles, sideline.
24. Refunds applicable to scratching's – ACA Rule D.5  
A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be give if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee.
25. When your ride has terminated, please help remove your beast quietly and in an ordially fashion.
26. **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH AND ARE TO BE KEPT AT THEIR OWNERS CAMPSITE AT ALL TIMES NB NO DOGS AT CUT OUT AREA.**
