- NLIS tags to be fitted
- Bulls less than 2 years to have NLIS tag fitted
- NLIS readings will be conducted before judging on Saturday morning starting 7.00am

**SPECIAL REGULATIONS**

- All cattle entered in the Stud Beef Cattle Section, must be entered or eligible for entry in the Approved Herd Book
- All Bulls 1 year and over must be led with a nose ring lead
- All winners must appear in the Grand Parade, otherwise Ribbons and Prize Money may be withheld
- Grand Champion Ribbons will be awarded only when competition is such that both Junior and Senior Champion Ribbons have been awarded. In circumstances where one of either a Junior or Senior Champion has been awarded, that Stud beast will be eligible for competition at inter breed level
- Age to be determined as at 1st September of the year of the show

**DPI REGULATIONS & CATTLE TICK TREATMENTS**

(For stock returning to Tick Free areas)

- Beaudesert Showgrounds does not have an approved livestock spraying facility
- Livestock exhibitors wishing to return to the Cattle Tick Protected and Free Areas should contact the Department of Primary Industries to arrange for return treatments at one of the Line Clearance Facilities
- A MINIMUM OF 48 HOURS NOTICE IS REQUIRED

**CONDITIONS**

- This competition is open to all persons under the age of 25 years as at 1st May, 2024
- Competitors under 18 years must have approval of parent or guardian to attend and it is the responsibility of parent or guardian to make arrangements on behalf of the competitor.
- All Competitors to be a resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to the competition or be attending a college in Queensland
- Eligibility: - National winners and persons on breed society senior judging panels are not eligible. Once a person has won the state competition twice, they are to stand down for two years.
- A competitor can represent only one Show Society in any Sub-Chamber final and only one Sub Chamber in the State Final.
- A show winner is not eligible to win at any other show but may participate after informing the steward of previous win.
- No Entry Fee is required, but entry is subject to approval of the Show Committee.
