Entry to the Beaudesert Show Grounds is via Jane Street (gate#6) and Tina Street (gate #5) - which will be open 3.00pm Thursday 26th March.
Entry onto the grounds is strictly prohibited before this time.

- No telephone nominations or late nominations accepted. The draw will be available on the Show's website & ACA website.
- All nominations must be via Campdraft One.

- ACA casual memberships are available.
- Limited to 8 first round runs excluding the open for open and futurity drafts.
- Cattle levy kept of \$30.00 per scratching per run scratched.
- SCRATCHINGS: if a competitor scratches from this weekend's draft program, then ACA D.5 rule apply.
- NO CHANGES to DRAW will be accepted after commencement of program. Changes to horse/rider combinations to be made prior to 60 minutes before the draft starts. Maximum of 2 changes only per competitor for the whole weekend.*
- Entry money to be receipted before nominations are allocated and prize money and /or refunds will be bank transferred after the draft to nominated Campdraft One account.
- Dress: Campdraft competitors must wear a hat (not a cap) or safety helmet, boots and collared, full buttoned long sleeve shirt and long trousers in competition. Competitors must be neat and presentable.
- Competitors must be suitably attired and mounted on the winning horse for presentations.
- Every horse to be named. All horses to be run in order of draw.
- All competitors in all events compete at their own risk.
- The decision of the Beaudesert Campdraft Committee on all matters will be final.
- In the event of a tie for first place, competitors concerned will compete in a further round to decide the winner.
- All conditions to apply at time of draft and nominations in any event will be taken as acceptance of the above conditions.
- HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Mini, Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- Prize Money to be paid as per ACA R6-R9
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- Only committee members and stewards are allowed to work in the ring.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the committee dismisses the complaint, the \$100 is forfeited.
- All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program
- No Alcohol to be brought onto Showgrounds.
- Beaudesert Showgrounds is a Glass Free Zone.
- The committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any event or entry and to refuse any nomination.
- Minimum Stallion Containment Requirements - ACA Rule 11.11
- All persons camping on the grounds must ensure electrical equipment has been tested and tagged within the last 12months before use at the showgrounds. No open Campfires.
- When your ride has terminated, please help remove your beast quietly and in an orderly fashion.
- All persons riding an electric scooter must be wearing a helmet at all times.
- DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH AND ARE TO BE KEPT AT THEIR OWNER'S CAMPSITE AT ALL TIMES. NB NO DOGS AT CUT OUT AREA.

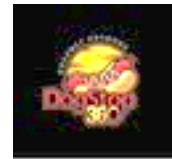

Shells Coffee and The Dessert Co Ice Cream will be on site all weekend

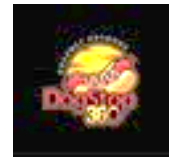
